
SUBJECT: PARTICIPATION OF DISTRICTS 5490, 5500 AND 5510 IN  
MULTIDISTRICT ACTIVITY ENTITLED THE ROTARY  
VOCATIONAL FUND OF ARIZONA, INC.

STATEMENT: In accordance with the policy established by the board with respect to district participation in multidistrict service activities and projects (Item 272, third meeting of the board in 1986-87), the governors and governors-nominee of Districts 5490, 5500 and 5510 (Arizona, U.S.A.) requested approval for authorization to undertake formation of the Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona, Inc.

District Governors Carl Paetz, Jr., George Papachoris and Bill Decker, as well as District Governors-Nominee Tim Creedon, Ken Rawson and Frank M. Crane, confirmed in writing (copies of their letters are attached) that at least two-thirds of the clubs in Districts 5490, 5500 and 5510 approved of their districts' participation in the multidistrict activity.

DECISION: The board has authorized the general secretary to act on behalf of the board in considering requests from district governors for authorization to undertake multidistrict activities or projects.

The board, the general secretary acting on its behalf, authorizes the governors and clubs in Districts 5490, 5500 and 5510 to form the Rotary Vocational Fund of Arizona, Inc. in Districts 5490, 5500 and 5510, subject to the activities being organized and continuing to be organized and conducted in accordance with established policy concerning Rotary district participation in multidistrict service activities and projects.
